

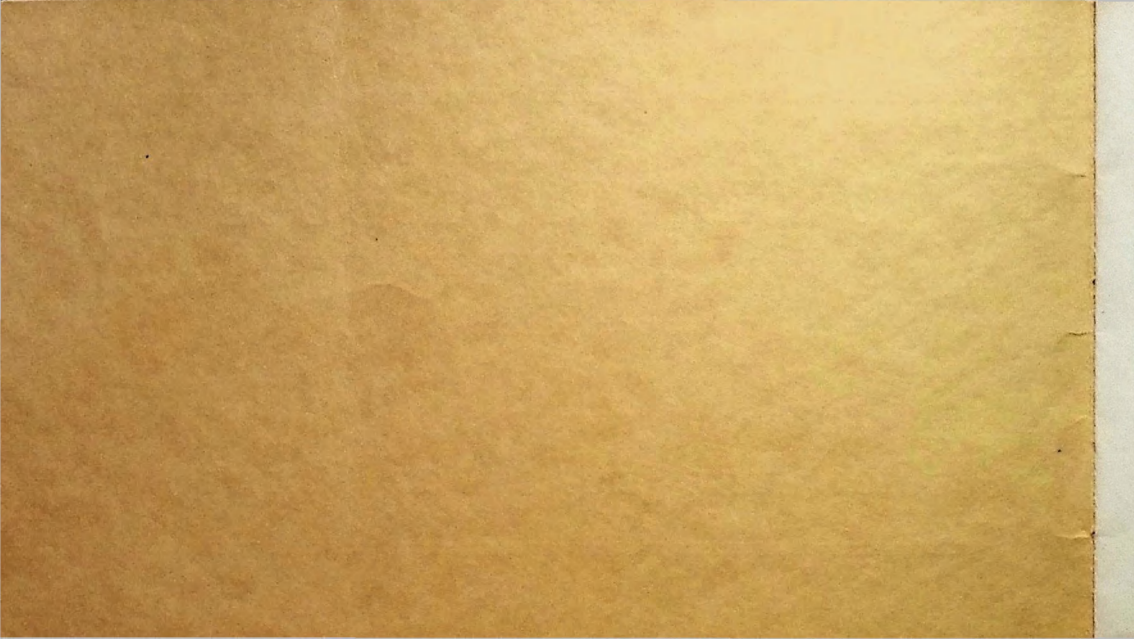

The ATLANTIC HOUSE

—[ESTABLISHED 1850]—

THE ATLANTIC HOUSE is located eight miles from Portland, Maine, at Scarborough Beach. A beautiful old grove of pine and fir trees makes a natural barrier which excludes it from the public road. Beautiful green lawns and flower gardens, the ocean in front and the pine woods in back, with ample grounds make a pleasing background. With no driveways in front of the house, the children are able to play on the lawns without fear of cars. From the hotel a board walk winds to a beach of fine, clean sands, where excellent surf bathing may be enjoyed. At one end of the beach are rocky cliffs over which the waves dash at high tide and which



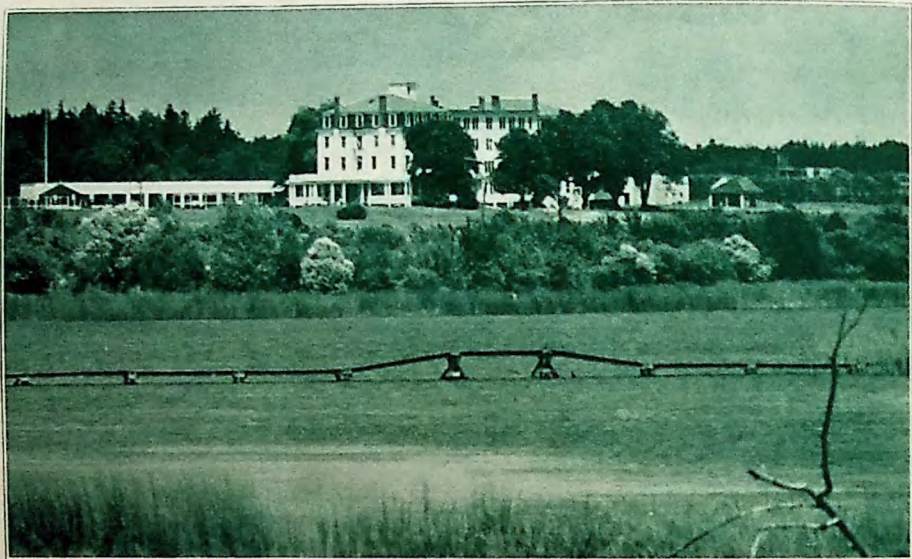
Driveway to Atlantic House, Scarborough Beach

are easily accessible at low tide. Only a mile away in the opposite direction is Prout's Neck.

A beautiful view of the ocean is seen from three sides of the house and comfortable chairs on the new porches and on the large sun porch make this most attractive.

On the first floor, heat has been installed in all the rooms and corridors. Every room is equipped with either hot and cold water or a private bath. Elevators run to all floors with entrance from the dining room or the lobby.

On the walls of the lobby, which is one of the best on the Atlantic Seaboard, hang eighteen large pictures depicting the early history of Scarborough. These were painted by the well known mural painter, Roger L. Deering of Portland.

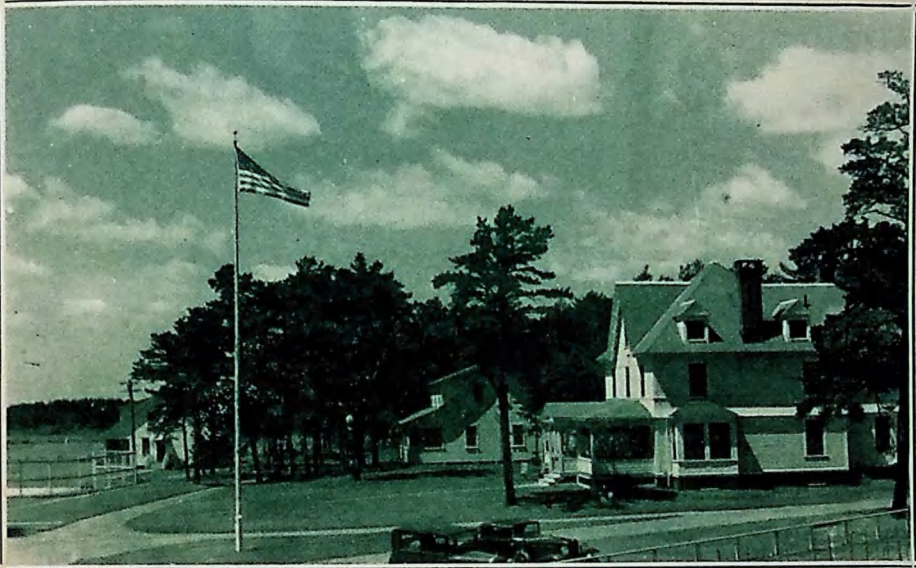

The water in the hotel is from Lake Sebago and is of unexcelled purity.

Special attention is given to cuisine with pure milk and cream, fruits in season, fresh eggs from our own poultry yards, and vegetables from our own gardens.

Outdoor sports are available with a tennis court and two shuffle board courts on our own grounds and golf may be enjoyed at the nearby courses of the Prout's Neck Country Club and The Willowdale Golf Links. Excellent fishing may be enjoyed from the rocks and deep sea fishing trips may be arranged at short notice. In the vicinity are many particularly beautiful walks and drives. Motors may be engaged by the hour. A new garage with twenty private stalls provides ample space for cars and chauffeurs are accommodated at reasonable rates.

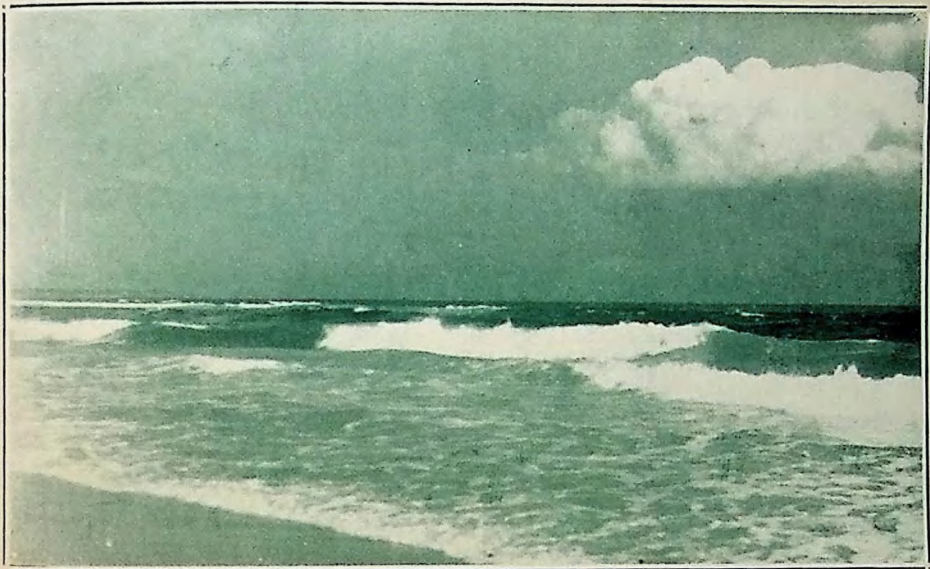
The Atlantic House is open from June 23 to the latter part of September.

How to Get There

Buy tickets and check baggage to Scarborough Beach Station, western division of the Boston and Maine Railroad.

Excellent train service from all Canadian points, via C. P. R. R.

Guests leaving Montreal in the evening arrive at Scarborough Beach without change in time for breakfast. Our motors will meet you at the station for a pleasant ride of two miles to the hotel.

Motorists coming into Maine over the new interstate highway take route No. 207 at Oak Hill. The Atlantic House is but five minutes' ride from this point.

Our motors will meet guests by appointment at the new Portland Air Port located at Scarborough. About 10 minutes' ride to the hotel.

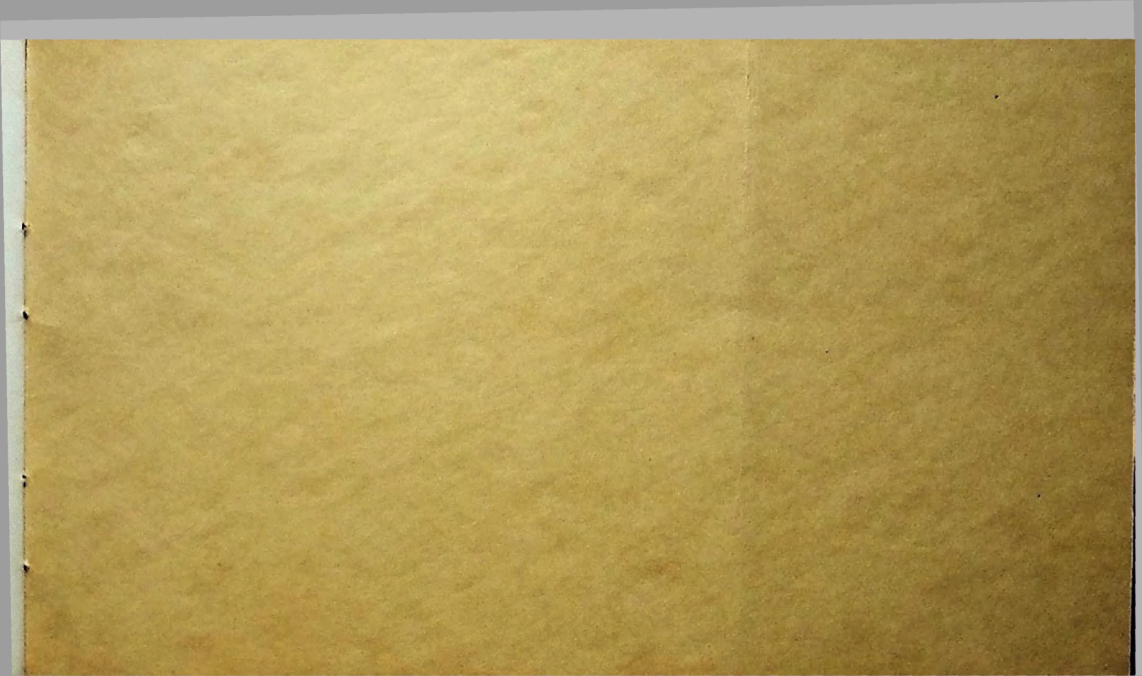
