This was on scouting duty "to the eastward". He was also in the Train Band of Scarborough in 1757, under Capt. Daniel Fogg, and served in Capt. John Smalls Company from 14 April to 7 Nov 1760, a period of 34 weeks. Snow Shoe Company under command of Capt. Dominic Jordan in York 14 April 1744, Falmouth.

SCARBOROUGH - Herbert B. McKenney, 85, a lifelong horseman who lived more than five years after a rare heart valve operation, died Sunday at his home on Beech Ridge Road.

Horses were Mr. McKenney's main interest most of his life, according to his granddaughter, Joan Harmon.

Herald selects one obituary and seeks to learn more about the life of a person who has lived and worked in Southern Maine. We look for a person who has made a mark on the community or the person's family and circle of friends in small but lasting ways.

He trained pulling teams and was a harness race driver and trainer.

He and his family operated a farm for several generations on Running Hill Road in South Portland. Jackson Brook, which ran across the property, was named after his grandmother's family.

As a young man Mr. McKenney used his teams of pulling horses to harvest ice for local merchants. During World War II he had nine horse teams that hauled logs out of the

woods to be used as lumber for the war effort.

After the war Mr. McKenney began training and racing horses at harness tracks all over Maine. He raced for many years at the former Gorham Raceway and on the Maine fair circuit. His work took him to tracks

throughout New England, as well as Canada, and in Florida during the winter.

On April 8, 1988, Mr. McKenney underwent the first heart valve repair operation performed in Maine. Dr. Christopher Lutes

The link I am having trouble proving is that of Henry McKenney who married Dolly Martin, 1803 and his being a son of Jonathan McKenney. Certainly circumstantial evidence points in that direction. And Jonathan did deed property to Henry, with no relationship mentioned in the deed. Henry's first two children were named Jonathan and Anne (the name of Jonathan's wife). I have been unable to find any vitals showing Henry's birth or baptism.

Since Jonathan was of Scarboro I have hopes you may have information that could help me.
